How To Correctly Bag Your Gently Worn, Used and New Shoes

- Use the clear bags provided by Funds2Orgs.
- 25 pairs of gently worn, used and new shoes in each bag.
- Tie any laces together or use rubber bands to keep pairs together.
- Put heels together toe to heel to prevent them from tearing the bags.
- When full, tie a knot on the top of the bag. Do not use rubber bands to secure the bags.
- Avoid moving bags too much to prevent them from tearing.
- Bag as you go, to prevent having to rush at the end of the shoe drive fundraiser.
- Mark bags off on the bag count sheet to keep track and relay to your coach weekly.
